POLICY 1-4-16 Effective: 1 January 2016

SUBJECT: Girlfriends/Boyfriends of Full Patch Members

- 1. There are times when members of CVMA 23-2 have significant others that are not married. In these cases the CBOD reserves the right to allow these friends to wear the CVMA 23-2 FRONTS only.
- 2. This is the 23-2 Scroll patch, the flash above it and their road name. In addition the back patch that says "vets helping vet" or other novelty patches IAW, National Bylaws. Although the National Bylaws do not permit friends to wear member patches, often times they are a huge contributor to the mission of the CVMA and should be recognized while participating in CVMA activities in this area.
- 3. NO Member Patches are authorized. These friends may wear FRONTS ONLY WHEN ACCOMPANIED BY OR IN THE PRESENCE OF YOUR SPONSOR. The following rules apply. The BF/GF/F must attend at least three meetings, they must have been with the member 90 days and must be approved to wear by the CBOD.
 - a. There may be times when the CVMA will have honorary members. The honorary member will be approved by the Chapter, State and National CVMA. The honorary member may wear the CVMA fronts.
 - b. The Sponsor of any girlfriend/boyfriend or honorary member will be held responsible for any infraction by their sponsored friend.
 - c. The friend may wear the fronts only in the El Paso area when in the presence of their sponsor.
