POLICY 1-5-16 Effective: 1 January 2016

SUBJECT: Clarification of required attendance to remain in "Good standing".

1. Each member should attend a minimum of at least one (1) event hosted by the Combat Veterans Motorcycle Association per year. This can also be an event in any member state if prior approval is obtained by the state representative from the governing body of the Combat Veterans Association. As CVMA 23-2 members in the local coalition of clubs additional guidance is in this policy.
2. Each member must attend (1) CVMA sanctioned event per year in order to be considered "Good Standing".
3. Every member must attend (1) CVMA 23-2 Chapter meeting per year in order to be considered "Good Standing". If the member is deployed or otherwise assigned for the year it is taken into consideration.
4. Life membership applications require that a member is in good standing for (3) years. The member must have (1) sanctioned event for each year to include (1) National Meeting. If the members meets the minimum requirement they are permitted to submit applications. The members is encouraged to use the CBOD to expedite the process however they may coordinate through the State Rep.
5. The CBOD reserves the right to discipline a member for non-attendance on a case by case basis. All members should be dedicated to the mission of the CVMA and attend veterans based motorcycle functions. The CVMA patch is never and should never be treated as a novelty.
