POLICY 1-6-16 Effective: 1 January 2016

SUBJECT: Election process. Additional policy requirements.

1. Each nominee must attend (1) CVMA 23-2 sanctioned event per year in order to be considered "Good Standing".
2. Each nominee must attend (1) CVMA 23-2 Chapter meeting per year in order to be considered "Good Standing". If the member is deployed or otherwise assigned for the year it is taken into consideration.
3. All nominees for any office must be active, currently in good standing and in the association with a minimum of 1 full year CVMA membership. The clarification of 1 year is that 365 full days constitutes 1 full year. Any full member may run for an officer position if that position is vacant and the member meets the qualifications.
4. Members nominated for office are qualified if he or she is a paid member, currently in good standing with the CVMA and have a minimum of 1 year membership.
5. All nominated members will submit a biography or letter of intent to run for election at the earliest possible date from acceptance to the membership.
6. All votes for officer positions will be conducted in a CLOSED BALLOT format. Ballots will be passed out to full patch members and accountability will be maintained by the SAA. The ballots will be collected by the SAA and counted by the CBOD and verified by two Full Patch members. The winner will be announced by the Commander.
